A normal meeting of St. Vincent's Board of Management took place.

The school has received its allocation for next year. An audit of EAL students was undertaken and an additional application was made for EAL hours. 10 hours have been approved. The Board approved a Senior trip to the Rhineland and a Junior trip to Lake Garda. These trips are to take place in May 2024. The finance committee approved an Electronic Banking Policy. The board has a bursary for a number of Leaving Certificate Students. This is funded by a past pupil. The school will see an increase in transition year students from 2 classes to 3. LCA classes will be amalgamated where possible. The student council addressed the board and detailed the work they have completed this year. The board was very impressed with their hard work to date. The board completed its risk assessment and safeguarding review. The board has identified students' mental health as the area of focus for this year. Upgrade to the school environment continues. First Aid training was provided for parents along with internet awareness
